

A safe, quiet lagoon protects our mooring of sailboats in sheltered waters, a short canal ride from Lake Simcoe.

Our clubhouse, located on the second floor of the Community Centre, offers a large multipurpose club room, a fully equipped kitchen, washrooms with showers and a spacious covered and screened deck. Trees, barbeques, picnic tables and a chiminea for friendly fireside setting dot the lawns between the clubhouse and the 30 docks, each complete with hydro and water.

Lagoon City Yacht Club (LCYC) is located on the eastern shore of Lake Simcoe near Brechin, twenty minutes south of Orillia off Hwy 12 nestled in Lagoon City, a residential community of 14 kilometers of winding waterways with a mix of residential homes, condominium style townhouses, several restaurants and shops. A beautiful sandy beach graces the mouth of the harbour – like being in the Caribbean.

The club comes to life in early May with the launching of our sailboats and a festive sailpast - boats decorated to lead a procession onto the lake saluting the new Commodore. Following the sailpast we celebrate the start of the new sailing season with a Commodore's reception. Enjoy the camaraderie of the members throughout the season with many activities including club racing, cruising excursions and social events in our clubhouse or on the front lawn.
